This paper presents and analyzes a unified dataset of annual U.S. troop deployments from 1950 to 2023. The global deployment of millions of U.S. troops has been the defining factor in international affairs for over 100 years, arguably more important than nuclear weapons and treaty alliances. The actual number of permanently deployed troops based in foreign nations has been trending downward over the short, medium, and long term, and is on a trajectory to zero before mid-century.
